

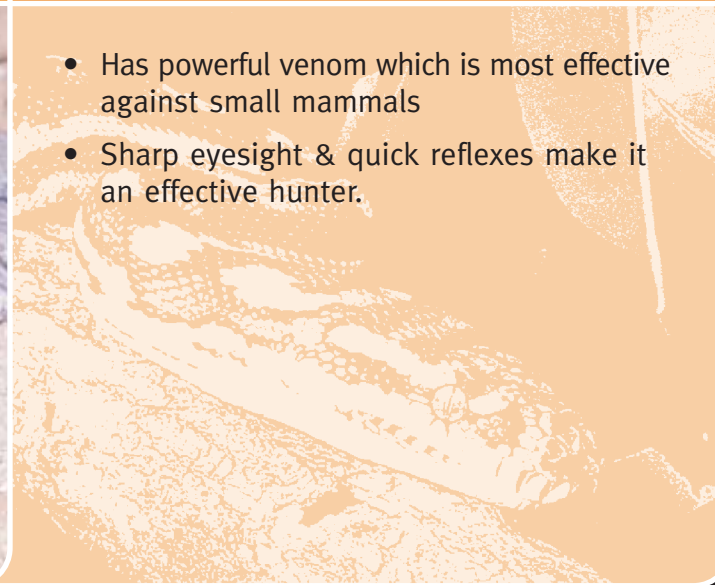
Eastern Brown Snake

Adaptation to environment

- Has powerful venom which is most effective against small mammals
- Sharp eyesight & quick reflexes make it an effective hunter.



Feeding relationships



What do I eat?

- Mostly mammals
- Also reptiles, particularly when young
- Prey captured by a combination of venom & constriction.

What eats me?

- This top predator has few enemies.
- Young eaten by Lace Monitors, birds of prey, larger snakes.

- Length: 1.5 m (may exceed 2 m) • Breeding: Lays 10 – 35 eggs.
